Parbold Residents Flood Action Group: For all those of you who were flooded in 2015 during the morning from the brooks and water running off the Railway lines please email: chris.grayling.mp@parliament.uk Secretary of State for Transport, and go to www. networkrail.co.uk/contactus - click on - 'Contact us form'. Please ask the following questions: Why in the more than two years since 122 properties were flooded here in Parbold, many of these by the Railway Line has absolutely nothing has been done? Why Is Parbold not even listed in the next round of Network Rail Funding? Aren't our homes and residents important? The 'WSP Alder Lane Flooding Alleviation Feasibility Study 2011' commissioned by Network Rail was shelved, WHY? The more of you that ask these questions the better chance we have of getting something done. In our recent Flood Training Session, several flood barriers failed, if this had been a real flood several homes could have been seriously flooded, please make sure yours are ready for use. There is a new, shorter document re Riparian Ownership at https://www.gov.uk/guidance/owning-a-watercourse and a Google Media Campaign- FLOODS DESTROY. There will be a community litter pick on Saturday 14th April 2018, meeting at the Village Hall at 10am. Gloves, hi-viz vests and litter-pickers will be provided. If you could please email the Clerk to let us know you will be joining in, we welcome everyone along. We continue to seek regular volunteers to work independently on particular routes on a regular basis and thank those who have already come forward to do this.

Through careful budgeting, the Parish Council is able to keep the precept at the same level as last year so there will be no increase in residents' council tax attributable to the Parish Council this April, indeed that component should appear on your statement as a slight decrease on the previous year.

There have been provisional enquiries from Network Rail to extend Bramble Way through the fields to meet with Chapel Lane so that the level crossing on Chapel Lane can be closed to meet their safety concerns. At this early stage, the Parish Council are not convinced that this is the only option and have asked that Network Rail consider instead upgrading the crossing to an automatic controlled barrier with obstacle detection as an alternative, because the new road would inevitably result in damage to the playing fields, car park and biological heritage site at Chapel Meadow.

Can we ask that enquiries about the new bin collection system be directed to West Lancashire Borough Council because it is not a Parish Council matter and the Clerk is not equipped to answer queries on this.
