Parbold Parish Council Annual General Meeting will be held on Friday 1st May 2020 in Parbold Women's Institute Hall at 7:30pm and residents are cordially invited to come along.

The Parish Council has had a busy year. The financial year ended with the conclusion of a joint project with the PCA to replace the heating in the village hall, following the successful application for grant funding to assist with the costs. Community Infrastructure Levy has been committed to renovating the two play areas, new play area surfacing, bins and benches have been installed at the village hall. A new tarmac pathway with drainage has been created at Burnside, and we hope to continue by replacing the swings and installing a new piece of equipment to replace the racing cars, removed last year. CCTV was installed at the village hall to protect the building. Community litter-picks last year were well attended and thank you to all those who volunteered. In the coming year attention will be given to combating antisocial behaviour, particularly youths gathering at the play areas, causing noise disturbance and damage after dark and unauthorised activities at Bramble Way car park.

Last year's Best Kept Village Competition was successful with encouraging judges' comments and commendations for Our Lady's Church grounds and the Old Post House. As we enter again this year please help to keep the area looking good, remembering to take litter home and clean up after your dog.
