Parbold Parish Council is currently recruiting a new Clerk, so please bear with us in respect of responses to correspondence for the time-being. Please use the email above to contact the Parish Council.

Parish Council meetings are continuing at 7.30pm on the first Friday of each month except August, in Parbold Village Hall. Members of the public do not take part in council meetings themselves.

However, anyone who wishes to make comments about any item that is on the agenda should make their wishes known at the beginning of the meeting to the Chairman. The Chairman will then allow the meeting to be adjourned to accommodate public participation to allow them to speak. Comments about items that are not specifically on the agenda may also be raised. There is a normal time limit of four minutes per speech.

There continue to be young people drinking alcohol and causing noise disturbance in the early hours of the morning at the village hall play area. Residents of Greenfield Avenue are taking the brunt of the noise disturbance. The area is under cctv which is made available to the police in these instances and any witnesses are requested to contact the police.
