Basic Awareness of Paediatric First Aid - Friday 7th July 12:30- 15:30 .This short introductory course, delivered by Lancashire Adult Learning, will provide learners with the knowledge and basic lifesaving skills needed to assess and respond to a child or infant that is unresponsive and not breathing. The skills will include how to deliver cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) on a child and baby and how to access and use a defibrillator. Learners will also be able to recognise and treat choking. This event is free to all adults over 19, and booking is required.
