At this time of year falling leaves can cause a problem when blocking gullys and drains. Don't forget that you can report any such issues directly to LCC via the **Love Clean Streets** App, along with other problems like pot holes and pavement obstructions. This speeds up the process and the Parish Council has recently heard of a number of successful reports where the problem was resolved quickly.

As football and rugby matches have resumed on the Alder lane playing fields it is imperative that dog fouling is not allowed on these areas. It is not only anti-social but very unpleasant for players. Dog walkers are reminded that dogs must be kept on a lead on the playing fields; there are open spaces on Chapel Meadow for dogs to exercise. Also, fertiliser is being applied to areas of the playing fields which may adversely affect dogs until fully absorbed so please take care if walking around the field.

Work is continuing on the small area next to The Heys, where weed pulling is taking some time but is very necessary to stop re-growth. Councillors have drawn up a sustainable plan of shrub and bulb planting and this will be implemented once the area is weed free.
