The new Parish Council website is now live and intends to give an insight into the Council and the work that it does, along with news and information relating to the Parbold community. Please take a look and let us know of any suggestions or feedback to improve the site, there is a comments section that you can use to get in touch.

The changeable weather this year has led to an exponential growth of many hedges around the village, and the Parish Council have received concerns about access along paths and roadways where hedges have grown out and are causing an obstruction. This is particularly concerning when pedestrians are having to walk out into the road with pushchairs in order to pass. The Parish Council ask that any hedges bordering the road or pavement are checked and cut back where necessary.

The Parish Council, in partnership with the Parbold Wildlife Group have successfully secured grant funding to improve access to the Chapel Meadow and work will begin in the autumn to improve pathways, fencing and woodland.
