Parbold Parish Council Notes

Parbold has been in the news recently demonstrating what we already knew – that it is one of the best villages to live in across the whole north west! Articles were included in national and regional press, including The Times and showcased the village for its historical, cultural and recreational merits.

Parish Councillors recently met with the United Utilities Risk Management team at the Hoscar site, to discuss recent issues of flooding, odour and poor water quality in Parbold. Although the instances of odour has dropped significantly, each episode is still unpleasant for residents and UU encourage the reporting of each instance so that it can be investigated. The most common cause seems to be the cleaning of the tanks and UU can issue a warning via the voluntary resident contact list held at their site. The issue of poor water quality is being investigated by a different department within UU but the team at Hoscar are keen to stay abreast of developments.

Local Neighbourhood police have recently been made aware of a number of keyless car thefts in Parbold and surrounding areas, specifically targeting Land Rover and Jaguar vehicles. There will be an increased police presence to deter these thefts but the police are asking that you take steps to protect your property.

Finally, the Parish Council are pleased to welcome two new members onto the Council. Councillor Dan McCafferty and Borough Councillor Katie Jukes both bring good experience and are keen to help to serve our great community.
